

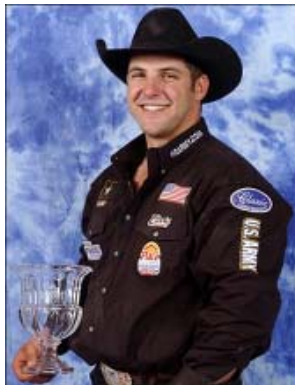

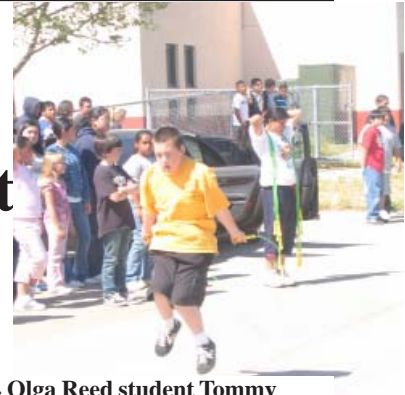

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## Summer Reading and Recreation Program for Grades 1-6

Olga Reed School is again offering to the first 100 students who register, a four-week program that will focus on reading, math and recreation. The program will operate from July 14 through August 8. Hours of operation will be 1-4 p.m. Monday – Thursday and Friday from 12-4 p.m. Cost for the four week program is only \$50 per student. Registration will be considered complete will the registration fee is paid in full. In order to accommodate planning, please return registration forms and payment as soon as possible.

Students will experience one hour of reading activities, one hour of math activities, and one hour of recreation activities each day. Reading activities will include Accelerated Reader, Book Clubs, board games and PowerPoint presentations. Math activities will include Accelerated Math, Snail Olympics, board games and the creation of PowerPoint presentations. Recreation will include sports, both team sports and individual, water games, cooking, and crafts. Each child will receive a nutritional snack each day. Each Friday we will go on a field trip within the county. Students will be required to attend the program at least three days per week (not counting Friday) in order to participate in the Friday field trip.
